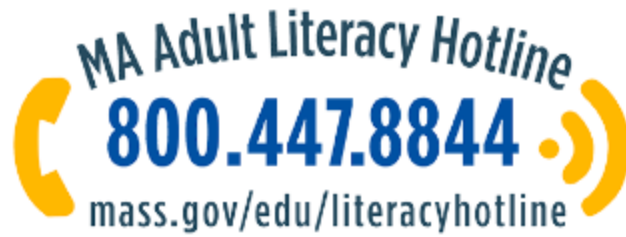

  - *From the DESE MA:* As teens apply for and begin summer jobs, the Attorney General's Office has information about [Child Labor Laws](#) enforced by their office and the [Youth Employment Permits](#) required for all workers under 18. In Massachusetts, all of the other wage and hour laws apply equally to minors and adults (i.e. minimum wage, overtime, etc.), and these protections and requirements apply regardless of [immigration status](#).
